Re: QClaims Web-based Version

The Early Intervention Central Billing Office (EI-CBO) is pleased to announce that the QClaims application is now web-based.

What does this mean:

- QClaims accounts may be accessed from any computer or device with an internet connection by using a browser such as Google Chrome, Firefox, or Safari. Internet Explorer is not recommended.
- Java is not required to access the web-based version.
- Secure billing.

Account information does not need to be re-created or duplicated. Provider, patient, claim, and payment information has been migrated to the web-based version for current QClaims Users.

To Access the Web-based Version Current QClaims Users Should:

- 1. Navigate to the QClaims log in website: <u>https://spiclaims01.eicbo.info/shuttle/login/form</u>
- 2. The Log In page will appear.
- 3. Enter the User ID formatted in two parts separated by an @ symbol. For example, UserID@OrgID
- 4. Enter your Password.
- 5. Click the [Log In] button.
