

Summary of QClaims Update 5.0



Below is a summary of fixes and new additions that were included in the May 2026 QClaims Update v5.0.5.

Bug Fixes, Improvements, and Changes

- New Message Center Display introduced with improved load times and sorting capabilities.
- Change to Grid result displays when No Results are Found for user clarity.
- Adjusted the default grid size on Batch Managers, Payment Managers, and other screens.
- Resolved issues related to warnings, warnings routing and warning focus.
- Introduced creation and last edited timestamps to Patient Records.
- Resolved issues when saving Service Units on Professional, Dental and Institutional Claims.
- Resolved issues with Professional Claim form navigation while using tab.
- Improved sorting on Message Center, Batch Manger, and Payment Manager.
- Corrected issues with Patient Autofill on Professional and Institutional Claims.
- Added the All Fields tab where all claim information can be edited on Professional, Institutional and Dental Claims.
- Added the ability to delete multiple Batches, Claims, and Patient Records at once.
- Resolved an issue related to batch totals when deleting records.
- Added the ability to transmit multiple batches at once.
- Added the ability to reset Search Filters on Manager screens.
- Refreshed ICD10 Codes with update values.
- Added the ability to do “To Batch” for 999’s and 277CA’s.
- Improved load time for Mailboxes, Payment Managers, Batch Mangers and more.
- Improved functionality related to saving and generating Reports.

- Addressed issues related to saving Service Adjustments.
- Added the ability to export from the Batch Manager
- Added the ability to Save Screen data on the Batch Manger.
- Resolved issue where the Mailbox password was being defaulted to “NULL” for Mailboxes that did not have a password setup.
- Improved functionality related to saving and deleting fee schedules.
- Fixed issue with tag assignment and when adding duplicates tags.
- Corrected issues with Claim Info button for multiple 835s.
- Resolved issues when setting Payer Aliases.
- Resolved issue with file prefixes not being appropriately overwritten.

Other Changes

- Remove support for the application. The Web interface will be the only supported version.
- Application moved to Java 17.
- SAML 2.0 Support is available to be added to the application; Contact us for more information.
- Removed SMS Two Factor Authentication Support.
- Resolved an error related to User Permissions when adding combinations of Organization and Site level roles.
- Resolved errors related to duplicate user roles.
- Adjusted user access permissions related to folders.
- Resolved a page error when entering an incorrect Organization at user login.
- Set application Protocols to default to TLS 1.2.
